Mission Moment – Christian Education

Reading the lectionary passages for today, I am overwhelmed. One mentions keeping a civil tongue, another finding wisdom, and still another following Christ and how that can change lives.

As a Christian educator, it dawns on me that our children can be the ones who change lives. They can be the face of Christ to the world.

Our church, Westwood Presbyterian, located in one of the wealthiest parts of Los Angeles, is bordered on all sides by expensive high-rises, megamansions, and grand compounds. In the midst of this abundance, the children witness the absolute despair of those without the physical, mental, or financial means to support their most basic needs.

Enter the Manna Bag ministry.

Our children's ministry raised funds to seed this new initiative, which provides care packages for people in our area who live on the streets. A Manna Bag provides enough food and water for one day, as well as socks, a toothbrush and toothpaste, wet wipes, and a resource sheet.

The children assemble the Manna Bags, which carry the message that God's grace is for all people, with no boundaries or exclusions. These tangible signs of care connect the children and the rest of our congregation to those whom Jesus cherished most.
