The website for the PA Criminal Clearance is <u>https://epatch.pa.gov</u>. Choose "New Record Check" (volunteers only). This website is user friendly. Please be sure to read each screen.

The website for the Child Abuse Clearance is <u>www.keepkidssafe.pa.gov</u>. Click on "GET A CLEARANCE" and read the information provided. It's easier to print the form and submit by mail but you can also choose to submit your information online. If you choose the online option, you will have to set up an account with a user name and password. This site is not user friendly.

Clearances are free for volunteers and are good for 5 years. Those who have lived outside of Pennsylvania in the last 10 years will also need to obtain an FBI fingerprint clearance. Information on this check is also on the keepkidssafe.pa.gov website. If you have any questions, please contact the church office 724-459-7991.
