

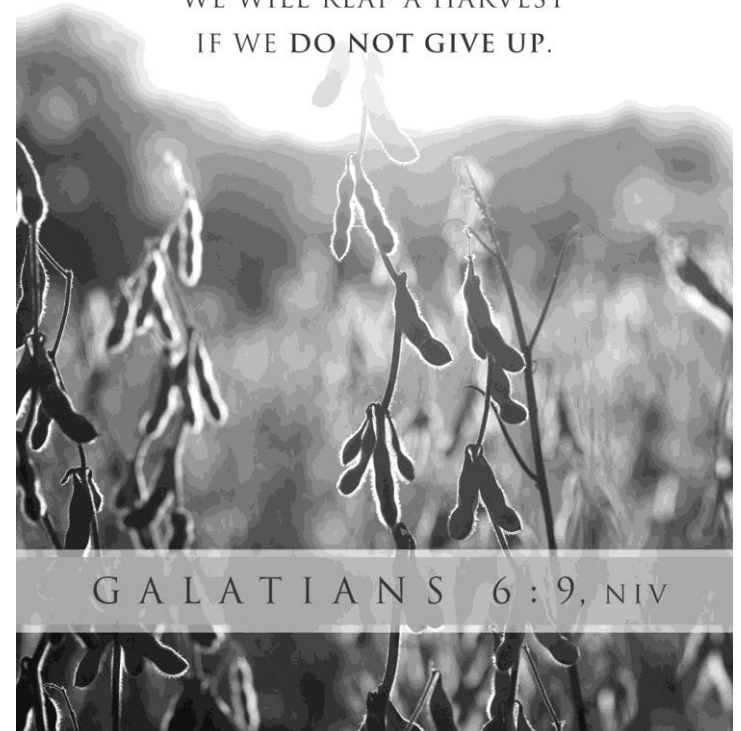

GRANDPARENT/OLDER ADULT CAREGIVER SUPPORT program is now being offered by Aging Services for those 55 years and over who are caring for children in their home. This is a reimbursement program for caregiver respite and supplies for children ages birth to eighteen. Some items that may be covered include, but are not limited to diapers, baby food, clothing, school supplies, recreational activity costs, and many more.
