\*Affirmation of Faith

(The Confession of 1967)

L: Having sung God's praise, having confessed our sin and been assured of God's pardon, having heard God's word, let us respond by affirming the faith of the church. What do you believe? P: God's reconciling act in Jesus Christ is a mystery which the Scriptures describe in various ways.
